

DoYo Wedding 2025 – Detailed Info Pack

Dear Friends and Family,

We are thrilled that you'll be joining us in Goa for our wedding celebrations! Before Arrival

1. Please **RSVP [here](#)** if you haven't already. This will allow us to make any necessary changes prior to the wedding, including ascertaining the headcount.
2. Please **email us your arrival and departure flights**, if you haven't already. This will help us check with the venue that all your accommodation is finalised and may help us anticipate any issues with check-in / check-out.
 - If there is a big group flying at the same time, we may be able to organise a group transport.
3. Double-check your flight details and **visa application details**. Ensure that the name and details on your application **match your passport exactly**.
 - **Note:** Confirm that the visa status on the [e-visa status enquiry](#) is shown as **Granted**.
 - If you haven't applied for a visa yet, please do so immediately. We have written a basic instruction guide that you can find [here](#).

Wedding Ceremony & Reception:

Wedding Ceremony:

1. **Private A/C buses** will arrive at **14:30** at the Goan Heritage Hotel to take guests to the Mae De Deus church in Saligao. The same buses will take guests back to the hotel after the celebration mass.
2. The Eucharistic celebration (Holy Mass) for the wedding nuptial ceremony at the church requires all to maintain and respect the sanctity of this place of worship. Please be respectful of the church setting i.e. shoulders covered, no shorts. The dress code is formal wear.
3. Given the time constraint after the Mass, all guests proceeding to the Wedding Reception are requested to kindly refrain from wishing the couple at the church. There will be ample time to congratulate and wish them at the Hotel reception venue.
4. We recommend that you have a big lunch before the wedding nuptials, as we will only be eating later in the evening at the Wedding Reception
5. For guests who will not attend the Wedding Reception, we have planned refreshments after the Mass, at the church.

Reception:

1. Canapes and welcome drinks will be served on arrival at 18:00.
2. The wedding reception will run till around 23:00 / 23:30.
3. And of course, there is an after party at the venue from 23:30 onwards! Bring your comfortable dancing shoes!

Beach Day:

Friday, October 31, 2025 @ 11:30

1. The beach shack will not be able to process card payments, so please bring enough cash for the morning / afternoon.
 - a. Around 20 - 40 GBP in rupees should be enough for drinks and food.
2. There are several providers of water sports (jet skis, parasailing, etc) on the beach. We are trying to organise a specific provider with better rates, but this will also need to be paid for in cash.
